Things to know before your start:

This document is 7.5" x 10". There is a 1/2" bleed on all sides. It is designed to be printed on 8.5" x 11" paper.

The bleed area on this document is for your registration and printing marks.

If you carry a dark image to the edge of the bleed, you will not be able to see your printing marks.


Use the Pantone colors provided. Making your own process or spot colors will make it difficult to print.

There is a layer for each color, but you do not have to keep your colors on separated layers. This is just a suggested workflow.

Attributes panel

Use the Attributes panel to selectively overprint your colors. *Overprint* means that you want to print one color on top of the other. The illustrator default is *knockout*, which will only print the top-most color where they overlap.

Turn on your Overprint Preview (View » Overprint Preview) to see the difference between overprint and knockout.



When you save this document for printing:

Go to Marks and Bleeds, and check the box that says "Use document bleed settings". Your sayed PDF will be 8.5" x 11".
