





CCS Student Health Insurance

This document serves to provide direction to CCS international students regarding health insurance.

In order to use your health insurance plan, you must first obtain your health insurance card.

You health insurance card looks like this:



By providing your health insurance card when you visit the Dr. or hospital, the healthcare provider will know to charge the insurance company.

Health insurance cards are available, each year, at the International Student Services Office. Students will be notified when the insurance cards become available for pick up.

The CCS student health insurance plan is administered through Student Assurance Services (SAS).

Healthcare Options and Finding a Local Provider

The CCS health insurance plan uses a network of health care providers: First Health.



To locate a local, in-network, doctor, you can visit http://firsthealth.coventryhealthcare.com/.

There are three options for healthcare

1. Making an appointment with a regular doctor

To make an appointment with a regular doctor, you should find one who is considered to be "in-network." This means that the doctor will accept SAS health insurance for payment.

On the First Health homepage, you can follow the "locate a provider" link to find a local doctor who will accept your student health insurance.



*** Always confirm, when you make your appointment, that the doctor still accepts your health insurance.

2. <u>Visit the Hospital Emergency Room (ER)</u>

If you have an emergency and need to be see a doctor as soon as possible, you may visit the Emergency Room of a local hospital.

The fee for visiting the ER, through the CCS health insurance, is \$150 for the visit. Please note, you may also incur additional charges as a result of the specific treatment that the ER doctors might recommend.

3. Urgent Care

Much like the ER, urgent care facilities are good resources for when you require immediate attention. The health insurance charge for an urgent care visit is also \$150.
